Answers: 1) B, Luke 13:1-5; John 8:34-47; I John 3:7-10 2) G, or C and E, 3) F -- as being a disciple involves not just living for God but "losing one's life" for the gospel and involves more than church attendance: which may actually hinder one's ability to serve God; See Mal. 3:18; Mark 3:31-35; 8:34-38; I Cor. 14:26-31; and I Pet. 4:10, 4) F -- as church attendance cannot save, cannot substitute for a personal relationship with God, nor compares to "losing one's life." 5) hears, believes, has passed 6) D, 7) E, 8) D, 9) F, 10) F, 11) F -- since they lived with Him daily for three years, 12) T, 13) T, 14) T, 15) T, see Matt. 3:11; John 3:1-16; and Eph. 1:13-14.
